

WANTED: 45s Label-Scan-Contributions for the Funky Music Records Lexicon (<http://www.funk.ch/funk-lexikon.htm>)

I'm looking for some high-quality scans...

Quality Scans means:

- Scanned with 300dpi resolution, in colour
- Measure of label at least 800x800 pixel or more (sample below is 1100x1100pixel) which is perfect (the picture should show the label plus about 1cm of the black vinyl surrounding it)
- Save in Windows (not Mac) Format: .TIF or not extra compressed .JPG! (saved with 300dpi, if the .JPG-picture of the above mentioned measure is less than 500KB or straight/curved lines look jagged, that means the picture is most likely extra compressed and therefore of lower quality and not optimal for the lexicon print)
- File-Size, no problem to **send files** of 1-10 MB to my Email p.wermelinger@bluewin.ch

Sample: the black part around the label is better ½-1 inch because in some cases I need to turn the picture and it helps if the label is not that much at the border of the picture. **(if you have any problems/questions, email me)**



Scans needed from the following listed 45s on next pages.

- If both sides are funky I prefer to get scans of both sides. If you can scan only one side, scan the side which is mentioned under the column "Top".
- Let me know about missing information or where is a "?" and any deadwax-markings (signs, letters, numbers in exact sequence) if possible.
- If possible, please send soundfiles in mp3/320kBits format or WAV or CD.
- If you have funky music 45s which you think should definitely be in the funky records lexicon, just send your contributions (infos, scans, soundfiles)
